• TREASURER

- Review the Treasurer's report
 - Approximately \$186k cash on hand
 - \$10,901.61 increase from 2023 to 2024
 - Largest Expenses:
 - Tent, Chairs, Tables
 - T-shirts, Security cameras, Maintenance items, Food, etc
 - Bow Blackhawk Open
 - Permits
 - Next 2-3 months larger checks will be going out until DNR reimburses their 75%
 - Tony made motion to approve Treasurer's report; seconded by Amy; motion approved
- Filed 990 for taxes is complete
- o Grants (DNR)
 - 2022: 2 elevated stand/handicapped stand, and 10-yard indoor expansion
 - 2023: pave parking lot: approved
 - Paving will take place May 8th, 10th, 13th
 - 2024: 5 additional wooden walls on outside 3D course; second handrail for ADA stand; concrete paths to
 outdoor shooting areas
 - \$2,000 grant from the City of Verona
