Board of Directors Meeting

• Meeting called to order by Dale Goytowski

Secretary:

- Review minutes from the previous meeting
 - ✓ Ed made motion to approve minutes; seconded by Jerry; motion approved
- O Date & time for next meeting: February 1, 2021 at 6:30pm at Blackhawk

• Treasurer:

- Review the treasures report
 - ✓ Approximately \$184K cash on hand
 - ✓ Approximately \$18K increase from 2019 to 2020
 - > Biggest check was written to town of Verona for property taxes
 - ➤ Net income is down \$5600.00 from last year
 - ✓ Jon made motion to approve treasurers report; motion seconded by Alan; motion approved

Covid-19:

- Onne County Health Covid-19 restrictions currently in effect under Emergency Order #11
 - ✓ Limits indoor gatherings to 10 people with physical distancing and face coverings.
 - ✓ Indoor gyms, courts, swimming pools can operate at 50% capacity. Scheduled activities are limited to 10 or fewer people who do not live together.
 - ✓ Allows outdoor gatherings up to 25 people (not including employees) who are not from the same household. You must be physically distanced from anyone you don't live with.
 - Masks are required for most people 5 years of age and older when in an enclosed space with people you don't live with.
 - ✓ At restaurants, indoor dining capacity reduced to 25% of approved seating capacity levels.
 - ✓ Indoor seating at taverns is not allowed; customers may enter taverns only to order, pick-up, and pay for food or beverage.

• Membership:

- Thru December 2020 we had 388 total members on 253 total memberships:
 - 86 complimentary members on 56 memberships
 - ✓ 21 early 2019 members on 11 memberships
 - ✓ 281 regular members on 186 regular memberships
- Thru December 2019 we had 363 total members on 252 total memberships:
 - ✓ 78 complimentary members on 53 memberships
 - ✓ 35 early 2018 members on 23 memberships
 - ✓ 250 regular members on 176 regular memberships
- Set up the 2021 Online Membership Application form
- Working member work hour log data Brian Kreutz
 - ✓ Of the 133 working memberships:
 - \triangleright 31 have completed their required hours 23%
 - ➤ 14 have completed at least half of their required hours 11%
 - ➤ 8 have completed less than half of their required hours 6%
 - ≥ 80 have not completed any of their required hours 60%
- Board approved waiving the work hours for 2020 due to the restrictions that were put in place due to Covid-19
 - ✓ Brian will reach out to each member individually
- So far 2021 memberships received:
 - ✓ 15 early sign-ups: new members
 - ✓ 11 membership renewals

 - > Continuing to work on this
 - ✓ A back stop is needed at the end of the 1st 80-yard NFAA target
 - Space is being cleared out for the construction of this
 - Rock pile is a deterrent, will not be able to dig into it; but continuing to work on this
 - ✓ Jon plans to build a platform stand in the broadhead shooting area
 - Revisit in spring
 - ✓ Replace boards on picnic tables
 - All but 2 tables have been placed against the shed to prevent rot from snow
 - ➤ Have some bases, will replace in spring
 - ✓ Relocate some bow hangers
 - Revisit in spring
 - ✓ Replace outdoor range targets
 - Was not able to complete this due to Covid-19; will revisit in spring
 - ✓ Schedule a club cleaning Alan Riggs sweeping has been done; no deep clean needed
 - ✓ Clean weeds out of broadhead bunkers
 - Area looks clean; will revisit again in spring
 - ✓ New targets arrived in December they have been taken to the shed, clean up is needed in the shed
 - ✓ Jon will work on changing the codes for 2021
 - ✓ Ice Age Trail needs clean-up from fallen trees
