• Meeting called to order by Dale Goytowski

• Secretary:

- Review minutes from the previous meeting
 - ✓ Dale made a motion to approve minutes; motion seconded by Jerry; motion approved
- Next meeting is scheduled for 6:30PM on April 6, 2020

Treasurer:

- Review the treasures report
 - ✓ Approximately \$172K cash on hand
 - ✓ Approximately \$21K increase from 2019 to 2020
 - ✓ Alan made a motion to approve treasures report; motion seconded by Dannielle; motion approved
- The annual nonprofit form 990 was filed with the IRS
 - ✓ Used Bob Kaufman with accounting firm Miller Brussell Ebben & Glaeske Deforest LLC; cost of preparation and filing was \$570 this year (\$550 last year)

• Membership:

- Thru February 2020 we had 220 total members on 137 total memberships:
 - ✓ 85 complimentary members on 55 memberships
 - ✓ 21 early 2019 members on 11 memberships
 - ✓ 114 regular members on 71 regular memberships
- Thru February 2019 we had 238 total members on 153 total memberships:
 - ✓ 77 complimentary members on 52 memberships
 - ✓ 35 early 2018 members on 23 memberships
 - ✓ 126 regular members on 78 regular memberships
- Brian has been able to collect 34 unpaid hours of 486 total or \$510 for 2019 of \$7,230.00 total
 - ✓ Concerned because this is twice of last year

• Kitchen:

- o Food Service License Public Health Dane County
 - ✓ Blackhawk's food preparation facilities failed an inspection on 2/27/2020
 - ▶ Blackhawk will not be able to sell food at the March brush shoot
 - ✓ Changes required to pass the inspection
 - > Need to install a mop sink in the furnace room and a hand washing station in the kitchen.
 - Steve Misustin estimates the plumbing cost at \$500 \$600
 - Need to modify the furnace room door to swing out to make room for the mop sink. Need to modify the kitchen cabinet & the kitchen countertop to make room for the hand washing station.
 - Ed Pierick will modify the kitchen cabinets & countertop to accommodate a hand washing sink. Ed will also order the sink.
 - Someone with a Food Server Certificate will always need to be on site when food is being served at Blackhawk. This is similar to the beverage server requirement.
 - \$15 for the certificate; need to renew every 3 years. If every board member completed the course it would cost \$345
 - Jamie will send the food server course link to the board members with the goal to have board members complete the course by the end of March
 - ➤ 2019 annual gross food sales was \$3100, our cost was \$2100 (without Vortex)

- Still would need to file for a temporary 3-day license if club did not pursue the 12 day Food Service license
- Ed made motion to approve mop sink & hand washing station installation & board members will obtain food service license with costs up to \$1500; motion seconded by Tony; motion approved
 - ✓ Improvements need to be completed no later than the middle of April to accommodate a follow up inspection during the last two weeks of April. The club would like to be able to serve food at the shoot on May 2nd and 3rd.
 - ✓ Dale sent Steve Misustin a follow up email, he will begin the plumbing work after 3/13/2020

• Maintenance:

- Recommended spring cleanup date April 25th
- List of projects/ideas for 2020
 - ✓ Jon will coordinate cleaning out the drainage ditch near Joe Pertzborn's property.
 - ✓ Problem cherry tree along shared border with Joe Pertzborn. Joe will cut the tree down.
 - ✓ Modifications to the 3D & NFAA outdoor ranges for safety concerns
 - ✓ Additional shelving in storage room
 - ✓ Bow hangers for outdoor range will finish in the spring
 - ✓ Chad Worrall is pricing out replacement storage room doors
 - ✓ Jon will work with neighbors to clean up yard in conjunction with building the platform stand in the broadhead shooting area
- Steve Misustin (master plumber) recommendations:
 - ✓ Put salt in the water softener
 - ✓ Clear sand from the water filter when changing the cartridge
- o Jerry recommended to hire someone to professionally come in to clean the floors in the club
 - ✓ Jon will talk to Frank; he is coming this Thursday to clean before the shoot this weekend
 - ✓ Jon & Alan will coordinate with the members who need hours to come in and assist

• Tournaments:

- o March 7/8 Indoor 3D Shoot
 - ✓ Set up will begin on Friday
 - ✓ Need board members to sign up for times to be present for bartending
- Kurt Baus recommended using Sign Up Genius website for worker sign up going forward
- Vortex Open
 - ✓ Bucky's rental reached out looking for size of tent & port-a-potties. Jerry will respond
 - Mark reached out to Mystery Ranch: offered 45% discount on a pack; suggested getting a pack, put weights in it & have people guess the weight (other clubs have been making \$1000/pack doing this). Mark will work with Jerry on this.
 - ✓ Mark reached out to Sawyer: will donate if club will post tick control information on website & social media sites. Mark will discuss with Kurt & Jason.

Leagues:

 - ✓ Changes were made to eliminate the conflict with the Thursday night target league
 - No class on Thursday March 26
 - Saturday March 28, 2020 Saturday class will be longer (probably finish around 3 or 4pm)
