- Review the Treasurer's report
 - Approximately \$185k cash on hand
 - \$10,753.21 increase from 2023 to 2024
 - Largest Expenses:
 - Membership, Food, Beer
 - Electricity, Internet, TV, Phone
 - Bow for Blackhawk Open
 - Amy made motion to approve Treasurer's report; seconded by Ann; motion approved
- o Grants (DNR)
 - 2022: 2 elevated stand/handicapped stand, and 10-yard indoor expansion
 - 2023: pave parking lot: approved
 - Project will begin in the spring of 2024
 - 2024: 5 additional wooden walls on outside 3D course; second handrail for ADA stand; concrete paths to
 outdoor shooting areas
