## • Maintenance:

- Damaged electrical feed from the Alliant Energy to the 3D storage shed (outside of shed, to conduit, to box) tree branch damage
  - ✓ Alliant is not willing to fix
  - ✓ Ryan Maier recommended that this electrical be buried; he is willing to assist will ask him to review and assist with quote
  - ✓ Dale will review options as part of the indoor range expansion project.
- Need to continue to recruit a maintenance assistant
- Construct a wire fence along the Blackhawk boundary & install signs
  - ✓ No change in status
- Deal with invasive species in the wooded areas based on Good Oak's recommendations
  - ✓ Jerry, Ann, and Tony had a meeting with Cody Didier, a Blackhawk member who works as a Forester for the DNR Cody will mark trees that are recommended to thin out and cut down
  - ✓ Spray needs to occur in the spring
  - ✓ Cody recommended planting Aspen & Pine in the future

#### • Tournaments:

- Toys 4 Tots shoot results
  - ✓ 22 shooters registered (one withdrew)
  - ✓ \$160 total cash donation (cash, ½ registration, chili/pie donations)
  - ✓ Jessica coordinated with Marine Corp Reserve to pick up the toy donations
  - ✓ 6 members came to volunteer at the event
  - ✓ Many thanks to Jaime, Jeff and Jessica for making this a successful event
  - ✔ Discuss future advertising for this event
- o Future of the Vortex Open Mark Noyce
  - ✓ Vortex will remain a sponsor and stated they will provide \$3k in optics and apparel prizes

    Mark will clarify with Vortex staff what the \$3k donation will include
  - ✓ Vortex name removed from event title due to their inability to support as in previous years

Name of the event will be changed to "Blackhawk Open" and will remain a one-day shoot.

Mark will continue to call around to find additional sponsors

Recommend creating tiered sponsors

- ✓ Vortex will assist in gathering other prizes as able (This is questionable)
- ✓ Vortex will continue to send an internal memo to solicit volunteers for the date of the event
- ✓ Vortex will no longer handle t-shirts

This would be an increased cost to the club

✓ Vortex received some complaints regarding the event & how it was different from years past

Vortex was evasive when Mark asked for details regarding the complaints.

We think the complaints were focused on the reduced value Vortex prizes and the lack of Vortex people on site to support the event.

- ✓ Can discuss an option for Vortex to provide demo products for attendees to check out at the event; will typically ask for a driver's license in return for loaner optics
- HHAUSA meeting with Chris Hamm on December 1, 2022
  - ✓ Shoot will take place on April 29<sup>th</sup> & 30<sup>th</sup> (Sat & Sun), 2023 from 8am 4pm
  - ✓ Veterans have option to tour Vortex facility on Friday April 28<sup>th</sup> starting at 2pm
  - ✓ Pre-registration will begin on HHA website early January 2023

Registration will be limited to 200 shooters/day to allow room for onsite registration

Registration Fee = \$20/shooter; 50/50 split (\$10/shooter to Blackhawk & \$10/shooter to HHA USA). Shoot times will be assigned

Extend half of the existing 20-yard-long indoor archery range by 10 yards

Dale Goytowski will manage the project

Construct multiple elevated shooting platforms on the outdoor ranges

- One of three are complete
- Recommend holding off on the elevated stand at the broadhead range until indoor facility expansion project is complete

Must complete the projects by September 30, 2024 to qualify for reimbursement.
